## **MEETING MINUTES**

The introduction meeting of the representatives of 2 complementary projects was held on 24 March 2021 at ZOOM platform for 1 hour and 15 minutes.

The meeting brought together WEBIN and UNIBL representing the VIRAL project and TeleGroup doo representing the AgroLIFE project. Purpose was to get to know each other, learn from each other about 2 projects, identify cooperation opportunities and achieve synergies.

The projects both started at the end of 2019, both have 3 years long duration and both focus on Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro and Serbia.

Project AgroLIFE is funded by GIZ (German Technical Assistance Agency) and implemented by NALED (National Alliance for Local Economic Cooperation) and TeleGroup doo. TeleGroup will pilot their AgroLIFE technological solution for smart management of agricultural land in pilot municipalities in 3 countries.

These municipalities include Sombor, Subotica, Inđija, Bačka Topola, Vrbas (Serbia), Prijedor, Trebinje, Brod (BH) and Danilovgrad and Budva (Montenegro).





#### We've agreed the following:


- Miljan Cvetković will send the presentation of VIRAL project to TeleGroup representatives,
