

Informative workshop on VIRAL hackathon for students of the University of Banja Luka

- Meeting minutes -



The workshop started at the planned time (12:00). The workshop was attended by representatives of the INNOVATION CENTER BANJA LUKA (ICBL) and Faculty of Agriculture in Banja Luka in charge of the implementation of the work package WP3, as well as students of the University of Banja Luka, interested in VIRAL hackathon in Banja Luka.



The operational part of the meeting began by introducing the present students to the upcoming hackathon in Banja Luka. Marko Rosić (ICBL) presented informations important for the preparation and organization of the hackathon itself. The way of applying, the topics that will be the subject of work on the hackathon, the rules of participation, the prize fund as well as the possibility of further work on their ideas in cooperation with ICBL. Marko especially pointed out the possibility of translating certain ideas into real business.



As part of the presentation, students also saw a video that briefly shows one of the hackathons realized in the previous period and the atmosphere of participation. Prof. Dr. Miljan Cvetković emphasized the importance of participation and benefits for the participants (students) who can have further work and advancement in their profession.
