

Bijeljina University Bijeljina – Project meeting and workshop WP2, WP4, WP5, WP8 14. 02. 2022.

Minutes

On 14th February the Bijeljina University hosted a working meeting of the current VIRAL project. Participants were informed in advance about the most important details of the meeting through its programme. The activity was realised within the work packages WP2, WP4, WP5, WP8.

A total of 14 in person and and 8 online participants took part in the meeting. After the welcoming speech of the director of the University, prof. dr. Bora Krstić, the working part of the meeting was opened by the project coordinator, prof. dr. Miljan Cvetković, who presented the results of previous activities on work packages.



The meeting adhered to the scheduled agenda. The first topic for consideration was the current status of project equipment purchase, i.e. work package WP2.2, where it was



stated that some members of the project consortium are still waiting for it, while some have already purchased it. The beginning of the second half of the current year is stated as the approximate deadline for the equipment purchase. There is a special review of the previously held EXPO event and the student hackathon competition below. The participants discussed possible disadvantages as well as possible advantages in the future regarding their organisations.



In the continuation of the work package WP2.4, it was talked about the current status and possibilities of publishing ToT materials, as well as its use in the coming period during the planned trainings and workshops. Representatives of INTERA, i.e. Ana Bogdanović, as well as Ana Mandić from the University of Mostar, spoke more about this topic.

In the further course of the meeting, i.e. the work package WP2.7, it was discussed about the ICT course in agriculture. Its role in the regular teaching process was discussed, more precisely in adapting to the existing faculty syllabi, i.e. formal validation at certain faculties. Representatives from the University of Tuzla and the University of Mostar, prof. dr. Aljo Mujčić, then dr. Alma Šećerbegović and dr. Alisa Hadžiabulić, took an active part in this work package.



After a short break, work resumed in the WP4 work package. Participants suggested ways to organise the next EXPO event in 2022.

The WP5 was included in the proposals and conclusions of dissemination of previous knowledge to other service providers, as well as an invitation for the meeting participants to be actively involved in the upcoming seminar "Challenges in Agricultural Production in 2022", which would in a way represent the dissemination of previous activities on project work packages.
